

God blessed us with the opportunity to work with our first 17 year old (pictured above), who stayed here with her parents' permission. We were glad to have her here and to see her grow each day as she experienced unconditional love for the first time in her life. We thank God for the restoration and hope he shows the girls during their time here and pray that he continues to reveal himself to them in new ways as they move on.

Mentor Families: We are excited to have two new mentor families - Scott and Amanda Coers and Stephen and Melissa Gober, of Midtown Baptist Church in Brownwood – working with our residents. Mentor families spend time with the girls on a regular basis, encouraging them in their journey towards freedom and showing them how a godly family operates. These families are invaluable to our ministry, as they become a part of our girls' support system and demonstrate the love of Jesus to them in a tangible way.

Aftercare: Part of our vision for this ministry is to extend our impact through aftercare. We are working to find ways to continue to connect with and serve our young ladies, their children, and their families after they leave our program. We keep in close contact with almost all of the girls who have been in our home over the past two years. We hope to be a part of their continued growth through long-term support and encouragement.
