Several of our residents have also recently reached major milestones in their lives and we are proud to share their achievements:

Jasimine also finished High School and graduated Valedictorian just a few weeks before being released from TYC to come to Hope Home. She was the second student in the history of the facility to graduate on the recommended plan, and she gave a beautiful speech which moved the crowd to tears and earned her a standing ovation. She is full of promise and has every hope for a bright future.

Samantha was accepted as a student at Howard Payne University and began taking classes there. She was also invited by TYC to be a guest speaker at a conference in San Marcos. She shared her story with over sixty teachers and encouraged them to persevere in their work of helping incarcerated youth. She has also worked very hard at home and is the first young lady who has completed all the levels of our program, reaching many of her personal and spiritual goals. We are blessed by her diligent heart and the sweet way she helps encourage the other girls in our program.
